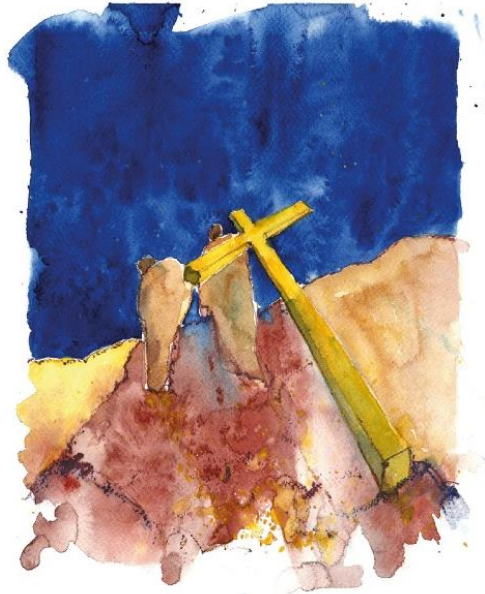


3 Mercy
