

## Lent 2021

For almost a year now there has been very little opportunity to raise any funds for the work of St Mary's so we hope that you will help us during Lent by taking part in this fundraiser.

Each day until Palm Sunday, we invite you to consider how blessed we have been despite the difficulties we have encountered during the pandemic and offer opportunities to make donations to our funds. Although we are suggesting an amount you might like to give, feel free to give less or more as you can afford and fill in each daily amount as you go.

On some days we are not asking you to make a donation, but rather to do something or pray about something instead.

The final day will be Palm Sunday, after which you may send us your donations. Details of how to do this can be found inside the back page of this booklet.

- Post a cheque made out to **Ross PCC** to the Treasurer c/o The Benefice Office marked on the envelope **Count your blessings**.
- Take cash or a cheque to the Benefice Office (Monday to Friday mornings only). Please phone 01989 562175 before you leave home.
